Dr. John G. Panagiotou is a theologian and scholar who has deep experience in pastoral ministry as an Orthodox Christian presbyter, denominational administrator, teacher at the university and seminary levels, preacher, and businessman in a career which has spanned nearly three decades. His research interest and teaching focus on the study of the early centuries of Christianity and on Christian stewardship.

Dr. Panagiotou is professor of New Testament, Biblical Greek, and Patristics at Cummins Memorial Theological Seminary where he serves as Liaison Officer to the Seminary President and is also a professor of Greek New Testament, Early Church History, and Theology at Erskine Theological Seminary.
