Certificate of African American Studies

The certificate program is for students who want to study African-American religious practices through sound theological studies and academic scholarship. The concentration will give students the tools to better serve the community and sacred space of persons of color. This rich, rigorous study offers in-depth knowledge and prepares students for further advanced studies and ministerial practices. The courses will carefully critique the contributions of the African and African American experiences to the Christian faith traditions. The program requirements are 18 (eighteen) hours. These courses are transferrable to completing the M.Div., Bachelor, or Diploma program.
